Resources for Pregnant Women Addicted to Heroin/Opiates

Medication Assisted Treatment

There are three recommended medical options at this time. Methadone maintenance and Subutex are the two most common medications for pregnant women who are addicted to heroin or other opiate drugs. Suboxone providers change with some frequencies therefore you can visit a website called www.suboxone.com/find a doctor to find a more current list of Suboxone physicians. You will need to call them to determine if they will accept you as a patient.

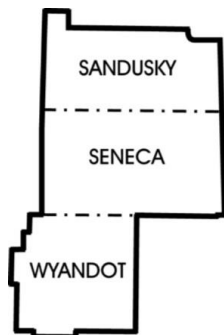
