National Seat Check Day

Tiffin, OH – Car crashes are a leading cause of death for children ages 1 to 13. Many times, deaths and injuries can be prevented by the proper use of car seats, boosters, and seat belts. Seneca County Safe Communities will host the Tiffin Fire Department to offer free car seat checks on Saturday, September 29, 2018 beginning at 9 a.m. at Hedges Boyer Park.

The event is part of National Seat Check Saturday. Tiffin Fire Department will discuss how to install and use car seats correctly and can help determine if your child is in the right seat for their age and size. Keeping your children safe is always a top priority. This includes using the right car seat, booster seat, or seat belt for your child.

The event will be in collaboration with the Mental Health and Recovery Services Board's second annual Max's Miles Suicide Awareness Event. There will be a half mile Kids Run and a Community Awareness Walk, as well as live music, bounce houses, crafts, food vendors, and other activities.
