



Family, Addicts and Community Together for Ongoing Recovery

The F.A.C.T.O.R. Support Group, in partnership with Seneca County General Health District, is offering free Narcan training to Seneca County residents.

Narcan (Naloxone) is a medication that can reverse or partially reverse an overdose that is caused by an opioid drug and can increase a person's chances for survival during an overdose.

The F.A.C.T.O.R. Support Group will dispense the Narcan and provide the training. Due to the current social distancing guidelines, we will limit to one attendee per training session. During a 15-minute training session, the attendee will receive one (1) kit, information on how to recognize an opioid overdose, how Narcan works, and how to administer Narcan correctly. Each kit contains two (2) Narcan nasal sprays, gloves, and a face mask.

Narcan training and kits are FREE and available to individuals in Seneca county.
